\$6,000,000

At \$6,000,000, the Community Trail Farm will be equipped with key amenities such as a new Welcome and Education Center that allows for more in-depth programming, historic building restoration, event and programming facilities, stream ecology improvement, and deeper land restoration.

\$5,000,000

At \$5,000,000, ORA Trails will be able to initiate further development, including a 2+ multi-use lane bridge, paved all-weather trail to increase accessibility, build service infrastructure and maintenance buildings, complete construction on 15 miles of world class trails, and provide basic restroom facilities.

\$4,000,000

At \$4,000,000, ORA Trails will secure land ownership, initiate trail construction, and continue programming. Operation and maintenance costs are also reflected in this number.

\$3,000,000

Now, in October of 2024, with the help and support of individuals, businesses, and organizations, we have reached the point to bring awareness and fundraising to the public. \$2,000,000

In April of 2024, ORA Trails received a Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Grant through the Knowles-Nelson Stewardship Program for \$1,150,000 for land acquisition. From 2023-2024, countless volunteers gave hundreds of hours towards restoring the land and cleaning up farm

\$700,000
